

Malabar Cements scam: action after studying probe, says minister

Palakkad: Kerala industries minister E.P. Jayarajan Monday said that a move has been initiated to take action after studying the vigilance probe against officials of Malabar Cements, including the managing director of the company. Any move towards destroying the establishment by leveling allegations against it won't be allowed, he said.

"All the same, offenders won't be spared. The government is not for truce with corruption," Jayarajan said and added that everyone including officials and trade unionists have pledged cooperation to solve various issues concerning the company as well as developmental activities. The minister also held talks with management representatives, trade union leaders, employees, among others.
